

Indian equity markets rose for a third consecutive session as optimism prevailed over ongoing U.S.-India trade talks and the U.S. Federal Reserve delivered its first rate cut of the year, citing recent sluggishness in the labor market. The U.S. central bank reduced interest rates by 25 bps to a new range of 4.00% to 4.25%, marking its first rate cut since Dec 2024, and signaled two additional 25 bps cuts later this year.

Maruti Suzuki India has announced price reductions of up to Rs. 1.3 lakh across its vehicle range, effective Sep 22, 2025. The cuts reflect the full benefit of GST along with additional discounts aimed at boosting demand and encouraging a shift from two-wheelers to four-wheelers ahead of the festive season.

IBM and BharatGen have entered into a strategic collaboration to accelerate AI adoption in India. The partnership will leverage BharatGen's sovereign multimodal and large language models, tailored to India's linguistic and cultural diversity. It combines IBM's expertise in AI data, governance, and model training with BharatGen's national mandate to build inclusive, India-centric AI systems.

Lupin has received approval from the U.S. FDA to launch a generic version of Lenalidomide capsules in various strengths (2.5 mg to 25 mg). These capsules are used to treat multiple myeloma, a type of blood cancer that affects plasma cells in the bone marrow.






IPO Process

Definition: An Initial Public Offering (IPO) is the process by which a private company offers its shares to the public for the first time, becoming a publicly traded entity.



Explanation

The IPO process begins with the company appointing investment bankers to underwrite the issue. Key steps include regulatory filings, preparing a prospectus, setting the price band, and conducting roadshows to attract investors. Once approved, shares are allotted and listed on the stock exchange. For example, Company X planning to raise ₹500 crore through an IPO will file a draft prospectus, obtain regulatory clearance, and then invite bids from investors. IPOs help companies raise capital for expansion, but they also bring compliance obligations and market scrutiny. Investors view IPOs as opportunities, but pricing and market conditions play a big role in success.
